FROM THOUGHTS TO ACTIONS

The thoughts shared by participants were reviewed. The following themes emerged from those thoughts that received an average rating higher than 4.0. The table below highlights the themes and the actions that we are taking as a result of the feedback received.

MENTAL HEALTH AND WELLBEING

“Provide resources for mental health supports”.

SUPPORT FOR LEARNING

“Provide professional development to build capacity in this new learning”.

MAKE CONNECTIONS

“It is very helpful to the parent and student to receive feedback and comments on their assignments”.



- Provide feedback about student work
- Enhance virtual connections with students
